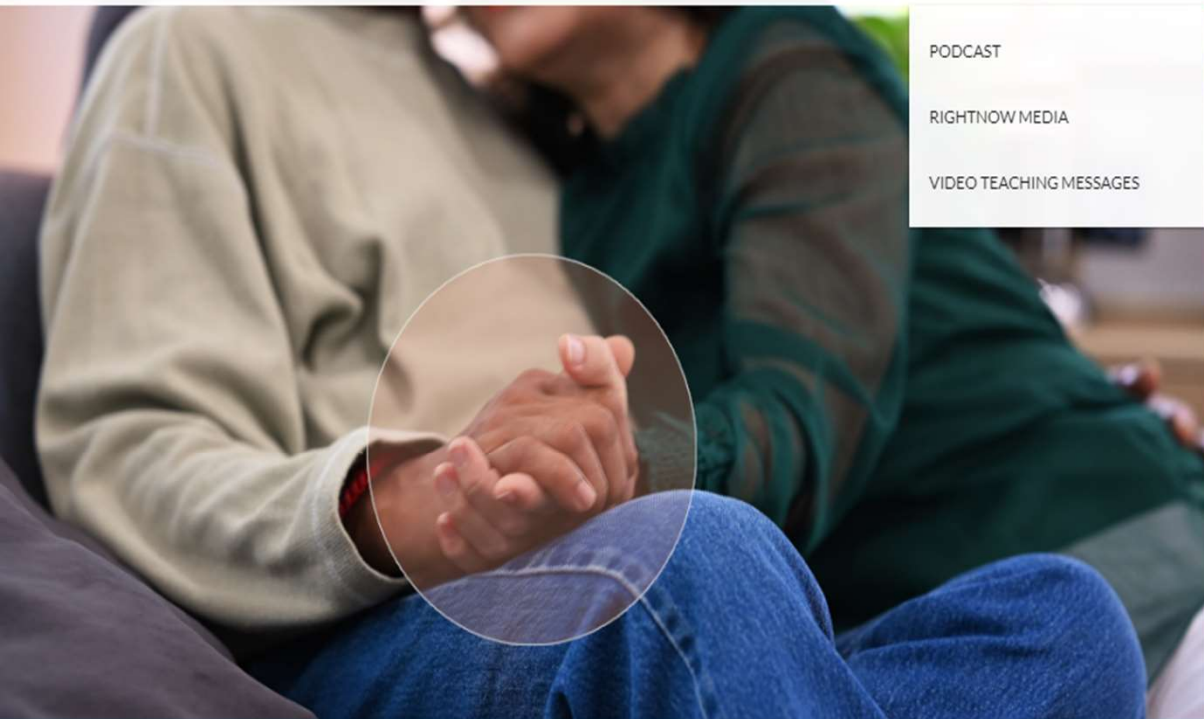

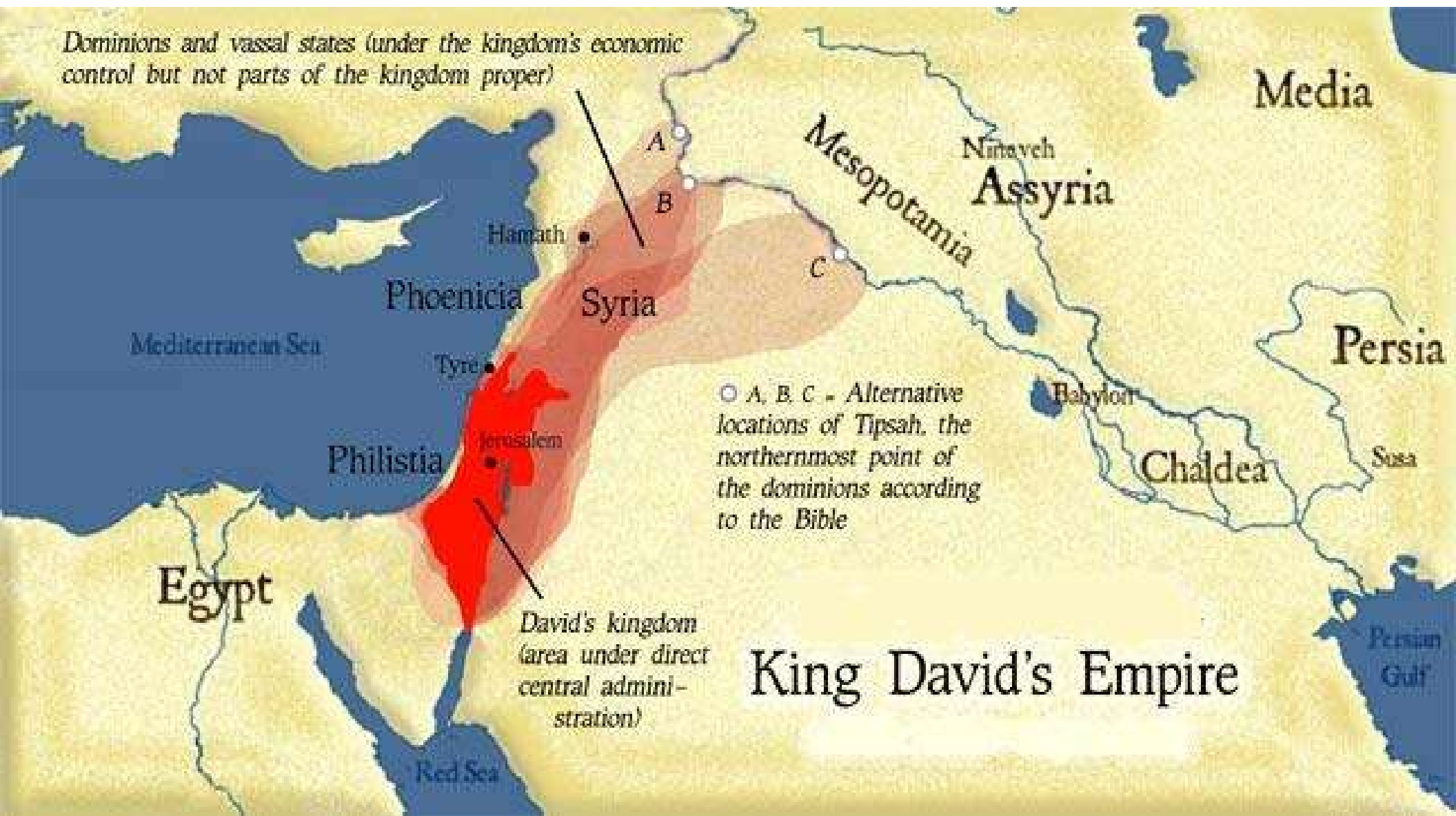
# What does the Bible say?

## Paul's world view

- 1 Cor 15: <sup>3</sup> For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received:
- Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, <sup>4</sup> that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,
- <sup>5</sup> and that he appeared to Peter,
- then to the twelve.
- <sup>6</sup> Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive,
- <sup>7</sup> Then he appeared to James (Jesus brother),
- then to all the apostles.
- <sup>8</sup> Last of all, he appeared also to me.
